Hey Now Records is proud to present *Drift*, the debut album from Boston-based Gaslight Revival, available in retail and on-line stores April 7th, 2009.

The initial framework for *Drift* was laid out over 10 years ago, but only came to fruition in 2007. David Mansfield and Trevor Jones, after many attempts to keep musicians around long enough to create meaningful music, finally decided in 2002 to go their separate ways, conducting their individual musical explorations on opposite coasts. Both eventually moved back to the Boston area, new experiences and ideas in hand, and decided to give the project that started so long ago its proper due.

Rehearsals started in October 2007 and by May 2008 twenty songs had been written and prepared for production. The stack was eventually whittled down to twelve and in June the first recording sessions for *Drift* took place.

Recorded over the summer months of 2008 and into the fall, *Drift* features 12 songs of love, heartbreak, personal discovery, personal conflict, and distant memories, topics that frequently find their way into popular music, but done in such a way that feels fresh and sincere.

Ryan Keeley, a Gaslight Revival fan, once described their music as “New England country blues”. They have also been described by fans as being “the band that is Ryan Adams, Nick Drake, Wilco, the Beatles, and the Rolling Stones all mixed into one”. Yes, a very heavy list of artists to be compared to, but *Drift* truly does hit the mark.

This is the album that took ten years to make. The wait was well worth it.
